2010 House of Delegates

What is the House of Delegates?

- It is the annual meeting of the voting members of the New York School Nutrition Association.
- It is the official governing body of the Association where constitution, by-law changes and resolutions are voted on.
- It is a place to find out what has been happening in Chapters around the state, and the committees of the Association. Chapter Presidents please prepare an oral summary of your year to present during HOD. (3 minutes)
- It is a place to meet chapter and state leaders.
- It is a place where a quorum is necessary to vote on motions brought to the floor.
- A quorum is made up of 2, 3 or 4 representatives from each *active* chapter (one having ten members), depending on the total number of members in the chapter as of June 1st, officers, area directors and committee chairs of the Executive Board and all past presidents who are present. A quorum is one third of this total.
- It is a place where we use Roberts Rules of Parliamentary procedure.

Why do we have a House of Delegates?

- Vote on Constitution and By-law changes and Resolutions
- Offer an opportunity for Chapter leaders and Executive Board members to exchange ideas for the growth and development of the Association.
- Each Chapter and Executive Board position reports on the year's activities

Who attends the House of Delegates?

- Officers, Area Directors & Committee Chairs of the 2009-2010 Executive Board
- All NYSNA Past Presidents
- Chapter Presidents, President-elects and other designated representatives (a minimum of two (2) members in good standing from each chapter). If you are an Executive Board *Voting Member* and a Chapter Leader, you will need to get a chapter member to represent the Chapter at the HOD. Each person may only vote in one position.
- Executive Director of the Association.
- All members of the Association are welcome to view the proceedings but may not vote.

The meeting was called to order by 1st Vice President Doloros Stinson at 8:50 am.

Roll call was taken, cards were not collected. A Quorum was determined to be in attendance.

Lance Seeber made a motion to accept minutes as read, seconded by Jay Gayle. Vote taken and passed.

A motion to accept agenda was made by Teal Carpenter and seconded by Anita Trautwein. Vote taken and passed.

The secretary read a thank you card from Sharon Bogue for the card we sent for her recent wedding.

Lisa Ostrowski, SNS, President of NYSNA gave two reports. One was an update of our financial outlook. The second report was on the responsibility of Executive Board service. Both were very informative.

1st Vice President Doloros Stinson talked in detail about the upcoming SNA membership option of district owned membership in which NYSNA will participate. With district owned membership, the district owns the membership. So if the district owned 20 memberships and had an employee leave and a new person was hired then the district could transfer the membership to the new person.

A motion “to change the agenda and eliminate the mega issue discussion so that chapters can give reports” was made by Mark Bordeau and seconded by Betsey Bacelli, vote taken and passed.

Reports from the Executive Board followed:

President Lisa Ostrowski, SNS, reported that she was awarded the Gold Award from SNA on behalf of the NYSNA.

2nd Vice President, Artie Frego, encouraged everyone there to promote membership. Secretary, no report given

Treasurer Teri Hopper, SNS, thanked everyone for working on their budgets and getting them back to her. She also reported that the investments were finally leveling off, no more losses.

Executive Director Carol Beebe thanked the chapters for coming.

The rest of the reports were given by each chapter if they wanted to share with the group.

Chapter highlights included:

- Membership growth
- Using email as a communication tool

- Back to basics with staff
- Using local chapter money to send local members to NYSNA annual conference for day or entire conference
- Every local chapter should be working towards gold, silver or bronze awards.

Conference 2009 Chair Debbi Beauvais, RD,SNS gave us a report that things were coming great for the upcoming conference in Rochester in October

Conference 2010 Chair Jay Gayle gave us an update on conference 2010 in Saratoga. Things are starting to come together.

- H1N1 Flu Pandemic, things to be prepared for
USDA has made it so that if your district or a building in your district has to close for a period of time then you could feed kids under summer feeding. There are many requirements you would need to be aware of so please check the SED website



Follow I-90 (NYS Thruway) to exit 35. Follow Carrier Circle to Route 298 East. Take first left onto Old Collamer Road. Continue to end, through four way stop, Hotel is at end of street on right.

From The South

Follow I-81 North to I-690 East. Exit from I-690 onto Thompson Road North. Continue on Thompson Road North to Route 298 East / Bridgeport. Take first left off 298 East onto Old Collamer Road. Continue through first intersection, Hotel is at end of street on right.

From The North

Follow I-81 South to I-90 (NYS Thruway.) Follow Thruway East to Exit 35. Follow Carrier Circle to Route 298 East. Take first left onto Old Collamer Road. Continue through first intersection, Hotel is at end of street on right.

From the New York City Area

Follow I-80 West to Route 380 West to I-81 North. In Syracuse exit onto Route 690 East then exit onto Thompson Road North. Continue on Thompson Road and follow signs for Route 298 East. Take first left onto Old Collamer Road. Continue to end, through four way stop, Hotel is at end of street on right.

From Syracuse's Hancock International Airport

Exit airport to Route 81 South. Follow 81 South to I-90 (NYS Thruway.) Take Thruway East to Exit 35. Follow Carrier Circle to Route 298 East. Take first left onto Old Collamer Road. Continue to end, through four way stop, Hotel is at end of street on right.
