He is also a member of the Council of Hotel, Restaurant and Institutional Educators, the National Association of Scholars, the American Culinary Federation, the National Restaurant Association, and the Chicago-Northwest Convention and Visitors Bureau.

Beach was awarded the 2008 Educator of the Year Award by the Northern Illinois International Food Service Executives Association.
