## **OVERVIEW**

IFSEA also strives to promote education, good fellowship and humanitarianism among its members and with people everywhere. **IFSEA Scholarship Grants are for the purpose of assisting deserving individuals to receive food service management or vocational training beyond the high school level.** Scholarships totaling almost \$100,000 are made available annually through IFSEA.
