



1. Filling and Wick Setting:

These lamps are equipped with our new *Permawick* wicking. During the first several uses, the cotton cover of the inner wick will burn away, leaving the permanent element of Permawick exposed. This permanent tip will not burn away, giving you a constant flame setting use after use

exposed tip of the permawick should protrude 1/16" this tightly and pull up more inner wicking. Replace the hex nut. The the hex nut to expose the unburned cotton cover of the inner wick.
