



Fallingwater Trip Cancellation Policy

Payments:

Total amount of trip is due upon booking. Reservations due by April 1, 2017.

Cancellations and Refunds:

Cancellations must be made directly to Monica Stage at the Martin House Restoration Corporation (MHRC) by phone or in writing (mstage@darwinmartinhouse.org or 716-856-3858, ext. 207). All cancellations are subject to a minimum fee of \$50.

Cancellation Fees:

90 to 60 days prior to departure – 50% of total trip cost

60 to 30 days prior to departure – 75% of total trip cost

30 days and under – 100% non-refundable

Medical Considerations:

This tour involves significant walking and requires participants to be in good physical condition. You must be capable to walk, without assistance, a minimum of one mile over uneven terrain and climb stairs that may not have handrails.

Limits on Responsibilities:

All services and arrangements for transportation, accommodations, and other services related to the tour have been made by the Martin House Restoration Corporation only as a representative of the participant. Therefore, the MHRC should not be held liable for any damages, expenses or other financial losses to a person or property arising out of injury, cancellation, delay, or alteration from any act of negligence by the hotel, airline, bus, restaurant, or company rendering services during the tour. The MHRC reserves the right to pass on to any participants expenditures, additional expenses, or losses caused by delays or events beyond its control. All participants will be asked to sign a waiver that will agree to waive, release and hold harmless the MHRC, the owners, operators, members, officers, directors, trustees, agents, successors and assigns, from any and all claims, injuries, causes of action, demands, costs, liability and/or harm of any kind acquired against each of them as a result of your participation in this event. This release shall not be effective if the claim or injury is the result of the sole negligence of the named entity. Should actual enrollments significantly fall below the minimum numbers, a surcharge may be added.
